Call for CBRC 2nd Graduate Students Award

Dear colleagues,

The Cancer Biology Research Center (CBRC) is pleased to announce the 2nd **Zvi and Esther Weinstat Graduate Students Award** for outstanding research achievements in the field of cancer. The call for proposals is directed to all **graduate students** who work on cancer related projects at Tel-Aviv University and the affiliated medical centers. During 2020, four awards of **5,000 NIS each**, will be awarded for outstanding research projects. The projects will be selected by four CBRC committee members and the Chair, Prof. Dan Peer. The awardees would present their work in this special event planned to be held on **September 8th 2020**.

About CBRC

CBRC is a joint activity framework of the Faculty of Life Sciences and the Faculty of Medicine to advance Cancer research at Tel-Aviv University. At present CBRC comprises more than 80 research groups that operate at the Tel Aviv University campus and in the affiliated medical centers. How to apply

Applicants should submit a 3-page proposal (English, font: Arial 11/Times New Roman 12, line spacing: 1.5) including:

- Project Title (only one line, up to 100 characters, not including spaces) on page 1.
- Principal Investigator (head of the laboratory (name, academic position and affiliation);
- Abstract (not exceeding 300 words).
- Scientific Background including the need, and hypothesis
- Project results
- References, up to 10
- A short CV (NIH style)
- Reference letter from the PI of the graduate student.

Eligibility

Application can be submitted only by Tel-Aviv University **graduate students** (M.Sc., PhD or MD-PhD.), whose research project is directly related to cancer and **will not complete their studies till December 2020**. **Deadline for proposal submission: 13/08/2020 Noon**. Proposals should be submitted electronically to:
