

2026 CBRC-GRAY-BRCA TRAVEL GRANTS - Call for Applications

The Cancer Biology Research Center (CBRC), in collaboration with the Gray Research Fund for BRCA-related malignancies, is pleased to offer travel grants of up to **\$1,500 each** to partially support active participation in international conferences, workshops, or courses.

Tel Aviv University graduate students, post-doctoral fellows, medical students, residents, and research associates engaged in cancer-related research are invited to submit applications. Preference will be given to meetings and scientific activities relevant to BRCA-related malignancies; however, applications addressing broader areas of cancer research are also encouraged, in condition that the work to be presented is BRCA-related. Grants are intended to support active participation in meetings **held abroad** through **December 31, 2026**.

The entitlement may be extended for up to 6 months from the date of receipt of the award notification for the requested meeting abroad. **Depending on the number of applications submitted**, grants **may** be limited to one applicant per meeting and/or laboratory.

Applicants should submit:

- Short CV (NIH style) - **up to 2 pages**
- Letter of recommendation from the supervisor - **up to 1 page**
- Research abstract as submitted to the meeting (including title, authors, and affiliations) - **up to 1 page**
- Details of the conference, workshop, or course (including date and location)

Applications that do not conform to the requested format will not be considered.


