## Cancer Biology Research Center - CBRC CONFERENCE GRANT 2016 Call for Applications

Dear researchers, dear clinicians, dear TAU faculty members,

March 2016

The Cancer Biology Research Center (CBRC) is supporting various aspects of cancer research at the Tel-Aviv University since 1980 in order to bridge between the research bench and clinical applications. During 2016 CBRC is offering up to 5000\$ grant supporting a one day conference in a cancer related topic to be held at Tel-Aviv University during 2016 and organized by a Tel-Aviv University Faculty member.

The conference should be about four to six hours including 2-3 sessions of about 1-1.5 hours each with a short coffee break. Sessions can have various formats (keynote lecture, talk show panel, flash presentations etc.) and should focus on a specific cancer related topic involving clinical and research aspects.

Proposals are selected to ensure the conference offers a comprehensive, noncommercial, objective, and diverse program. Attention will be given to diversity of affiliations, presenters, and relevance of the topic to broad academic and clinical audience.

- Applicants should submit a **3-page proposal** (English, font: Arial 11/Times New Roman 12, line spacing: 1.5) including:
  - Conference Title (only one line, up to a maximum of 100 characters, not including spaces) on page 1.
  - Organizer/s (name, academic position and affiliation);
  - **Summary** (not exceeding 300 words) **on page 1** Presenting the topic of the conference and its current relevance for the scientific community
  - Suggested participants and program
  - Proposed budget allocation
  - Requested budget

In additional pages, the applicants should provide:

- A short CV and list of publications during the past 5 years (NIH format).
- Eligibility: The submitting investigator must be a Tel-Aviv University faculty member or a researcher in a Tel-Aviv University-affiliated hospital. An investigator may submit only one application. Junior clinical faculty members (Instructors) are encouraged to apply!
- **Deadline** for proposal submission: **15/07/2016**. Proposals will undergo external peer reviews
